

Chaplain's Corner

By the time you read this we will have gone through Holy Week. This year is somewhat unique in the religious community in that while we do have the typical interaction of the Jewish holiday of Passover with Easter, this year our Muslim friends are celebrating the holiday of Ramadan. So, we have the world's three great religions each celebrating at the same time of year. However,

there are many in our community who do not profess or may be hostile to organized religion.

One question that is frequently asked by many Marines and Sailors is about who is the Chaplain for the atheist? It's pretty easy to figure out who the Christian Chaplain is given the cross Insignia worn on the collar or the Star of David for the Jewish Chaplain or even the Crescent for the Muslim Chaplain. So how do you identify the Chaplain for the people who do not believe in a higher power? The simple answer is that every Chaplain has the ability to counsel every serviceman no matter what their religious beliefs. The constitution of the United States guarantees the free exercise and protection of the individuals religious faith. When you joined the military, you did not surrender that right. And just as the Navy Chaplains are there for our Marines and Sailors the MCL Chaplains are here for all of our members.

So, while I can certainly assist Protestants in their observance of their faith, I also know quite a bit about the Roman Catholic faith, Judaism, Islam, Hinduism, Sikhism and many more. It is my job to support and to accommodate everybody regardless of your own faith tradition.

The office of Chaplain is not just to provide a religious officer to the organization to offer prayers at meetings. The Chaplain has loftier purposes:

To help members grow as individuals and particularly in their relationship with God.

To help members grow in their relationships to one another and become a true comrade to one another.

To serve as a reminder of the transcendent in life.

To develop an environment with which comrades are encour aged in their personal and collective moral and spiritual growth. To remind all Americans that God is the source of all rights and privileges.

We must be reminded that the Marine Corps League is comprehensive in nature, embracing all religions and faith groups within its ranks. The Chaplain, being non-sectarian and nondenominational, must minister to the spiritual needs of all without regard to either affiliation or non-affiliation. For many people, the only religious contact they will have will be with the Chaplain. Chaplains will need to provide ministry to people wherever there is a need. Should you need someone to talk to about spiritual matters, your health or you just need to get something off your chest, give me a call.
